Demolition - information and guidance

The Building Act 1984 contains provisions that enable local authorities to control demolition works for the protection of public safety and amenity and to ensure adjoining premises and the site are made good on completion of the demolition. Issues about noise, dust, and hours of work are controlled by the pollution control team. Site safety is controlled by the Health & Safety Executive

If you intend to demolish a building you are required to notify us **at least 6 weeks beforehand.** You must also notify the utility services (water, gas and electricity: see contact details below) and the occupiers of all adjacent buildings.

On receipt of the notice the site will be visited to determine whether conditions need to be imposed to control the process of demolition, if remedial works are needed to adjoining buildings, the effect on services and the treatment of the site on completion. In order to do this the application should be accompanied by:

- site location plan to a scale of not less than 1:2500 with the building being demolished shown in red
- a method statement of the demolition
- support and/or weather protection details to adjacent buildings if applicable
- an asbestos site survey
- confirmation that the site is suitably fenced or hoarded.

We have a maximum six weeks to issue our notice of conditions but will aim to do this earlier wherever possible. It is unlawful to commence demolition until this notice is given. You are required to notify us at least 24 hours before commencement and before existing drains are sealed or removed in order that we may inspect as necessary during the course of demolition and on completion to ensure that the conditions we impose are met.

You may also need to consult with the development control team when the building is to be demolished. Our Highways team may inspect the condition of the existing pavements and road surface so that any damage as a result of the demolition may be reinstated at the expense of the person carrying out the demolition. If any temporary road closures or alteration to pedestrian routes are necessary please seek advice from our Highways team. Attention is drawn to the Construction Design and Management Regulations that apply to all demolition works and to the Party Wall etc Act 1996 in respect of works to party walls, party fence walls and party structures.
