IF THE PROPOSED ORDER IS MADE, the stopping up will enable the development of the Land at / adjacent to Prospect Ring N2 8BP, Barnet as described in Schedule 2 to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to TBG Open Door Limited by the Council under Part III of the Act on 23 October 2018 under reference number 17/6827/FUL and will be for no other purpose.
