NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE A STOPPING UP ORDER SECTION 247 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

NOTICE is hereby given that the London Borough of Barnet ("the Council") acting in its capacity as local highway authority proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) ("the Act") authorising the stopping up of the highways described in the Schedule below and shown hatched with black diagonal lines and the highways shown shaded solid black on Drawing No. 18037-00-121 Rev N attached to the Order.

IF THE PROPOSED ORDER IS MADE, the stopping up will enable the redevelopment of the land at 100 Burnt Oak Broadway HA8 0BE to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Edgware Iron Works Limited by the Council under Part III of the Act on 30 April 2020 under planning reference 19/1049/FUL and will be for no other purpose.

The Council may disclose the substance of any objection made to the making of the Order to other persons affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector.

If no objections are duly made to the making of the Order, or if any objections are withdrawn, the Council may make the Order as an unopposed Order. Any objections duly made and which are not withdrawn will be referred to the Mayor of London.
