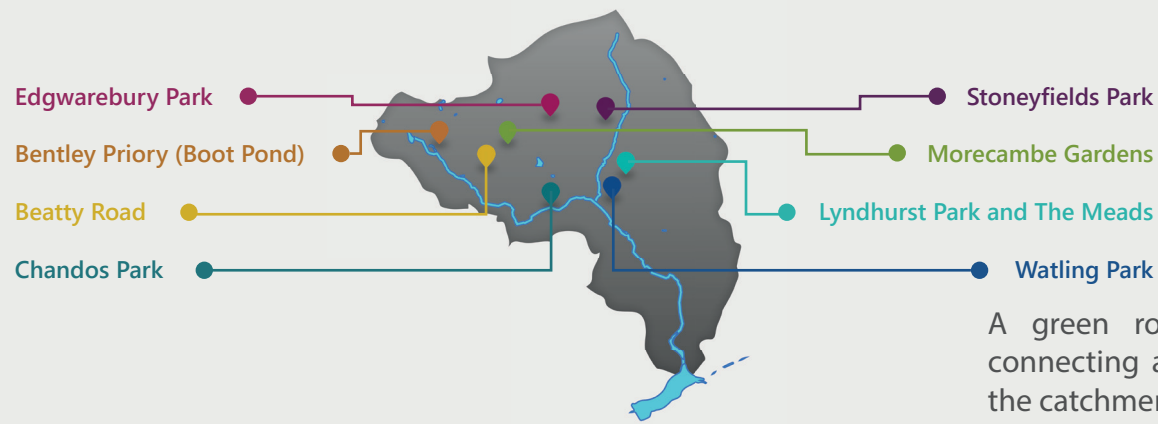


# ACTION FOR SILK STREAM Year 1 and 2 evaluation

## 8 planned projects

An ambitious six-year partnership project being led by Barnet and Harrow Councils that will work with nature to reduce the risk of flooding in the Silk Stream catchment.



A green route, the 'Silk Stream Way', connecting a community of parks within the catchment is also planned.

## Project funding secured

£6m funded by Defra as part of the £150 million Flood and Coastal Resilience Innovation Programme, managed by the Environment Agency, match funding has also been secured.
