Reported Scams in Barnet

 In December, some 215 people in Barnet reported a scam, with a total loss to victims of nearly £840,000!

 Older people can be particularly vulnerable to fraud and scams, which can have a serious impact on quality of life and wellbeing.



About the service

- We will aim to prevent older people from falling for scams by increasing their knowledge and confidence to recognise and deal with attempted scams
- We will also be creating links with local organisations and community groups to give people the tools to stay safe, our scams advisers will provide one-to-one support to vulnerable older people,'
- We will also be working with participants on our computer support sessions, helping them to stay safe when they're shopping online.'



What we can offer

- One-to-one support for anyone over the age of 50 who has concerns about scams, has been a victim of a scam or would like some tips on how to avoid them
- Group talks and presentations across Barnet to organisations supporting older people such as community groups, social groups and sheltered housing schemes.
