Free testing for sexually transmitted of infections (STIs) or HIV

Not everybody gets symptoms, so if you think you are at risk it is important to get tested, even if you think you feel fine.

Emergency contraception

Emergency contraception is available for free from Sexual Health London **www.shl.uk**, and Barnet Sexual Health Clinics (the emergency coil may be offered in clinic).

It is also available to buy at many pharmacies.

 Under 25s can get emergency contraception for free from some community pharmacies in Barnet.



PrEP and PEP HIV Prevention



PrEP is a medication for people who are HIV negative, to help prevent them from getting HIV if they are at high risk. PEP is a treatment that can stop an HIV infection after the virus has entered a person's body. It must be taken as soon as possible after exposure but within 72 hours. Regular contraception



Visit a Sexual Health Clinic for free advice and services for all methods of contraception including implants and coils.

Condoms and the C-Card. Condoms protect against both unplanned pregnancy and STIs. Anyone can get them for free from Sexual Health London www.shl.uk or one of Barnet's Sexual Health Clinics.

 Under 25s can sign up to the C-Card scheme and pick up free condoms from local outlets like pharmacies, youth services and shops. www.brook.org.uk/c-card.


