The Local Government Pension Scheme (Amendment) Regulations 2019 [Sl 2019/1449] – survivor's pensions now payable to the opposite-sex civil partner The above regulations are effective from 31 December 2019. The new regulations introduce survivor benefits that are payable for opposite-sex civil partnerships. A person who is the surviving opposite-sex civil partner of a deceased member will now be provided with a survivor pension, calculated on the basis that the survivor is a widow or widower, depending on their gender. It covers: Administrative delays between 2011 and 2016; A request for the member to pay the cost of a specialist report (which is incorrect - the member's former employer should meet the cost); and The fact that once the pension was awarded in 2016, it was only backdated to 2015 and not 2011 (member left the LGPS between 1998 & 2008 and, under those Regulations, benefits paid on ill health grounds should be paid from the date of the member's original request for payment - 2011). The Ombudsman upheld the member's complaint and, to put matters right, instructed the Council to consider backdating the ill health pension to May 2011.
