**NOTICE OF MAKING A STOPPING UP ORDER  
SECTION 247 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the London Borough of Barnet (“the Council”) acting in its capacity as local highway authority has made an Order on 24 June 2021 under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) (“the Act”) authorising the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule below and shown hatched with thick black diagonal lines on Drawing No. 23624002-STR-HGN-100-DR-D-10004 Rev P0 attached to the Order (“the Map”).

The Order will enable the regeneration at Brent Cross, Cricklewood to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by the Council dated 23 July 2014 under reference number F/04687/13, and will be for no other purpose.

Any person aggrieved by the making of the Order and desiring to question the validity of the Order (or of any provision contained therein) on the ground that the Order is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for supervision or quashing of the Order or of any provisions contained therein.
