

BYE-LAWS

relating to

COMMON LODGING HOUSES

1969

BYELAW relating to common lodging houses made by the Mayor, Alderman and Burgesses of the London Borough of Barnet acting by the Council of the said Borough under Section 240 of the Public Health Act, 1936.

Revocation of byelaws

The byelaws relating to common lodging houses which were made by:-

1. the Urban District Council of Hendon on the 7th day of September, 1931, and were confirmed by the Minister of Health on the 22nd day of September, 1931;
2. the Finchley Borough Council on the 17th day of December, 1934, and were confirmed by the Minister of Health on the 20th day of February, 1935;
3. the Urban District Council of East Barnet on the 15th day of July, 1935, and were confirmed by the Minister of Health on the 2nd day of September 1935;
