ENABLING WORK – Brent Cross Thameslink

I am writing to inform you that Network Rail needs to undertake work near to your property for the Brent Cross Thameslink project, part of the Brent Cross Cricklewood regeneration programme.

This ground clearance includes removal of vegetation and non-native invasive species. There will also be some earthworks to level the site to prepare for future construction of the replacement train driver accommodation and railway sidings for the new Brent Cross West station.

We will be active on site between 08:00-18:00 from Wednesday 30 May 2018 with works expected to run until end of September 2018.

To undertake this work, we will be using a variety of equipment that may include chainsaws, flail machines, chipping machines and excavators.

We will also be installing a temporary rail line adjacent to the existing sidings, to remove spoil from site and minimise the construction traffic on the local road network. It is anticipated that one train per day will be required which will arrive and leave during the daytime.

The nature of this work and the equipment we use means some disturbance is unavoidable, but we will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary noise. Furthermore, those working on site are briefed on working responsibly in the local community.

Network Rail or our representatives will carry out an ecological survey before we start. Any protected species or nesting birds will be identified and appropriate methods of working will be put into place.
