The above order was made on Thursday 7th May 2020. The effect of the order will be to extinguish the public footpaths described below and as shown by bold black lines on the attached map with reference 23624002-STR-HGN-100-DR-D-01003 Rev P3 ("the Map").

- 1. 91 metres of public footpath as shown by a bold black line running between point A and B as indicated on the Map from the south western end of Clarefield Park to the junction with the eastern end of Claremont Way;
- 2. 110 metres of public footpath as shown by a bold black line running in a northerly direction from the junction with Claremont Way between point C and D as indicated on the Map;
- 3. 78 metres of public footpath as shown by a bold black line running broadly north east through Clarefield Park between points E and F as indicated on the Map;
- 4. 46 metres of public footpaths that run opposite the Rosa Freedman Centre as shown by bold black lines running between point D and G on the Map;
- 5. 101 metres of public footpath as shown by a bold black line running broadly north east through Clarefield Park between points D and H as indicated on the Map; and
- 6. 49 metres of public footpath as shown by a bold black line running in a broadly southerly direction through Clarefield Park between points H and I as indicated on the Map.
