THIS ORDER is made by the London Borough of Barnet ("the Council") acting in its capacity as a local highway authority and in exercise of its powers under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") as amended by Section 270 and Schedule 22 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The Council authorises the stopping up of the highways described in the First Schedule to this Order and shown on the Deposited Plan, in order to enable the development described in the Second Schedule to this Order to be carried out in accordance with the following planning permissions granted under Part III of the Act by the Council:
 - i. Planning Permission dated 18 March 2019 with reference 18/6645/FUL;
 - ii. Planning Permission dated 11 April 2019 with reference 18/6409/RMA;
 - iii. Planning Permission dated 28 February 2018 with reference 17/6662/RMA; and
 - iv. Planning Permission dated 18 October 2019 with reference 19/2291/FUL.
- 2. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any area of highway authorised to be stopped up under this Order then, subject to Section 261(4) of the Act, those statutory undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of that apparatus after that area of highway is stopped up as they had immediately before the making of this Order.
- References to the "Deposited Plan" shall mean the plan numbered 23624002-STR-HGN-100-DR-D-01002 Rev P4 deposited at the Main Reception, 2 Bristol Avenue, Colindale, London NW9 4EW.

DATE OF COMING INTO FORCE

 This Order shall come into force on the date of confirmation of this order, and may be cited as the Brent Cross Cricklewood Regeneration Phase 1A North (Claremont Way East) Stopping Up Order 2019.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

Description of highways to be stopped up

The highway areas/references and zones listed in the table below and shown hatched with thick black diagonal lines on Drawing No. 23624002-STR-HGN-100-DR-D-01002 Rev P4 attached to the Order. The dimensions quoted in the table are approximate averages and have been rounded to the nearest half metre. The drawing should be referred to for exact locations.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

LOCATION

Land at Claremont Way (East) to the north of Claremont Road, NW2

THE DEVELOPMENT

Construction of highways infrastructure and associated public realm comprising High Street South (East Works), Claremont Park Road (Part 1), Claremont Avenue (south of High Street South (East Works) and Claremont Road Junction North, required in association with Phase 1 (South) of the consented redevelopment of the Brent Cross Cricklewood regeneration area (Ref: F/04687/13). Proposal includes including enabling works and other works incidental to the highways and public realm development (18/6645/FUL).

Provision of a new Neighbourhood Park (Claremont Park) comprising improvements and modifications to Claremont Way Open Space, changes to levels, hard and soft landscaping measures, the introduction of play equipment, park furniture, a pond, fencing, shared pedestrian and cycling routes and all associated enabling, incidental and temporary works (19/2291/FUL).

Details relating to layout, scale, appearance, access and landscaping for a residential-led mixed use development of Plot 11, comprising 352 residential units, flexible retail (Use Classes A1/A3), provision for a ground floor Neighbourhood Police Unit, basement and undercroft car parking, cycle parking, refuse storage and plant to be provided within two buildings with heights ranging from 8 to 13 storeys arranged around a private courtyard, together with an east-west publicly accessible route between the two buildings (18/6409/RMA).

Details relating to layout, scale, appearance, access and landscaping for Plot 12, comprising of 292 residential units, ancillary housing office, flexible retail, café, basement car parking and plant including heating plant, to be provided within two buildings with heights ranging from 6-13 storeys arranged around a public pocket park and private courtyard together with north-south and east-west tertiary streets for the provision of access (17/6662/RMA).
