I am writing to express my concerns regarding the Edgware Policy in the proposed Main Modifications to the Barnet Local Plan.

I live in Edgware with my young family. We use Edgware underground and bus transport on an almost daily basis for commuting to work, shopping and leisure. We use the Broadwalk shopping centre very often, as well as other shops and pharmacies in Edgware. And Edgware is also where we get medical attention in our GP surgery. In short, Edgware, its shops and medical facilities are the centre of our lives.

As a resident of Edgware, I understand the plan has been under development since 2020. However, I only recently became aware of its existence and its potential impact on our community.

I found the volume and complexity of the Local Plan and the related documents overwhelming. The 42-day consultation period seems insufficient for anybody to comprehend the plan's details – especially for anyone with work or caring commitments.
